Wednesday	Phonics - Can you help to make a yummy super smoothie by matching the pictures that start with the same sound?	In this lesson, we will be exploring the character of the unlucky man from the perspectives of other characters in the story. Which means somebody else's point of view. You are also going to be pretending to interview the characters from the story!	To warm up your brain and body for your times tables practice - have a go at this super movers dance!  Today you are going to be drawing and interpreting pictograms in 2s, 5s and 10s. It would be really good to practise your times tables to help you do this!	In this lesson, we will learn what a habitat is and look at examples of habitats. We will also build simple food chains of organisms that live in woodland, pond and savannah habitats. Wednesday Support	Today I would like you to review the sound U. We often find this sound in the middle of words. Today, we will be learning about the 5 oceans on our earth and the location of them in relation to the 7 continents. We will be looking at which continents surround the oceans. You can either type this or write it on a piece of paper on page 21. There is space for you to draw me your favourite picture from the A Card for Dad.
