Monday	<p>MyOn reading - this should be half an hour every day, your child can read a book of their choice</p> <p>Spellings - I spelt with le</p>	<p>We are continuing our work from pre-half-term on witches. In this lesson we are going to plan our information text about our very own witch by boxing up our information.</p> <p>The teacher in the video will ask you some questions, most of these will be on your slides so instead of writing down your answer, write it on the slides.</p> <p><b>Top tip:</b> Have a look at the questions on the slides, before watching the video.</p>	<p>This week our maths focus is data and how we represent it. You will be given examples of data on a tally chart &amp; asked a series of questions. For example how many more spotty socks are there than plain socks? You will also be given a set of data and asked to draw your own tally chart to represent it.</p>	<p>Science, The Living World: Plants is continued this week- Why are bees attracted to flowers? Lots of plants rely on insects like bees to reproduce. Complete the lesson to learn how bees are vital in this process. There is a fill in the gaps activity, a film clip to watch &amp; a quiz to test your knowledge.</p>	<p>P.E with Joe - half an hour, you will need a space and some water. Do not feel you need to do this in one go, take extra breaks if you need them.</p>

This is set out like a tally chart but instead of using lines as the tally, the date is presented in repeating pictures.</p>	<p>Science: What are the requirements for plant growth? Plants can't grow healthily without 4 key ingredients. Watch the clip to learn what these are, then complete the two activities to test your knowledge.</p>	<p>P.E with Joe - half an hour, you will need a space and some water. You will be asked to look at the data, then answer questions which read the data directly, for example; how many goals did Jack score during the match? You will also be asked to compare data, for example: How many more goals did Jack score than Dora during the match?</p>	<p>Science: Why are plants important? Plants are really important for the planet and for all living things. Watch the clip to learn about all the benefits that plants give us. Next complete the two activities to test your knowledge.</p>	<p>P.E with Joe - half an hour, you will need a space and some water. Thursday	<p>MyOn reading - this should be half an hour every day, your child can read a book of their choice</p>	<p>In this lesson we will write about where our witch lives and what their home is like. This calls for descriptive writing using lots of rich adjectives (describing words) to bring the witch's home to life. For example; Inside the living room, the furniture was all made of old, dark, gnarled wood. It looked most uncomfortable and it must have been made over one hundred years ago!</p>	<p>Today we continue to further develop our work with data interpretation by introducing bar charts. These are more in depth than the previous tally &amp; pictograms and require the children to look at the information horizontally along the x axis ( the bottom of the chart ) and the vertical information on the y axis (down the side of the chart ).</p>	<p>R.E - Judaism</p> <p>In this lesson we will learn more about the different ways that Jews express their faith today. Firstly complete the revision quiz to refresh your learning from last week, then watch the clip about Charlie and Adam, who are both practising Jews, to learn more about their daily life and how their faith impacts on what they believe and what they do.
