In order to achieve our aim, we subscribe to the following:

- **Evaluation**
The school needs to be able to judge how successful it is in realising the values for its pupils.
- **Progress**
Teachers will select sufficiently challenging assignments that will ensure pupils' knowledge and skills progress at the right pace.
- **Continuity**
Learning at school will be a part of a continuous process. If a pupil changes teacher or school, details of their previous work and development should help decide their future programme.
- **Growth**
What children learn and do in school should contribute to their emotional, physical, intellectual, social and spiritual growth. How teachers relate to each other and use their contacts with other professionals, should contribute to their continuing development and acquisition of experience.
- **Entitlement**
All pupils are entitled to high quality, well-planned and well-organised teaching. Staff are entitled to high quality in-service training and career development.
- **Opportunity**
All pupils should have equal access to the best resources and opportunities available in school.
- **Equality**
All pupils and staff are of equal value regardless of gender, race, ability or background.
- **Participation**
Pupils should participate actively in their own learning, solving problems by trial and error and exploring a variety of ways of expressing themselves. Teachers should participate in the management of the curriculum. Parents should participate in the education of their children both at school and at home.
- **Community**
The school should identify and foster opportunities to work with the community.
