### Message from Mr Fry and Mrs McGonigle

Dear parents and carers

As you are aware, we have seen a rise in positive Covid cases at Middleton this week. We'd like to thank all parents and staff for their patience and understanding as we get used to a new way of managing Covid cases in school. We met virtually with Public Health England on Tuesday to seek their advice and have reintroduced a number of measures to help keep us as safe as possible, including:

- One way system at drop off and pick up
- ▶ Staff wearing face coverings in communal areas
- ▶ Limiting the number of children eating in the school hall and switching to virtual assemblies and meetings.
- ▶ Making sure all windows are open and hands are washed regularly

We know that it's the season for coughs and colds, but if your child does display any Covid symptoms, please keep them at home, book a PCR test and let the school know the result. We are both parents ourselves and totally understand how anxious you feel about sending your child to school at this time. We are not allowed to close classes or trace close contacts anymore if there is a positive case, so we all need to work together the best we can to keep the children and each other safe. If you have any questions or worries about attendance, Covid or your child's safety, please contact the school office. We will continue to email parents with updates and information.

With Covid still in our communities, we all need to do the right thing to keep rates as low as possible.

① Say yes to the vaccine. That's both doses.

Everyone over the age of 18 can now get the jab.

Remember there must be an eight week gap between your first and second jab.

#### ① Get a test if you have symptoms.

If you have symptoms of Covid-19 – a high temperature, a new or persistent cough or a loss in sense of taste or smell – book a test at www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test and self-isolate.

#### ① Self-isolate if you are asked to by NHS Test and Trace.

Lots of support is available for people who need to self-isolate including payments of £500 and help with accessing food and medicine.

#### REMEMBER

- MEET PEOPLE OUTDOORS OR IN WELL-VENTILATED PLACES IF YOU CAN
- KEEP A POLITE DISTANCE FROM OTHERS
- WEAR A MASK IN CROWDED PLACES OR WHERE YOU CAN'T KEEP A DISTANCE
- WASH YOUR HANDS WELL AND OFTEN





Covid has not gone away. If your child has any of these symptoms please do not send them to school and book a PCR test:

A high temperature

A persistent cough

A loss of taste or smell.

Please visit a testing centre if you can, rather than getting a postal test.

Lateral Flow Tests, the type you can collect from chemists, should not be used on children under 11.



Children **must** bring in a named water bottle.








