### Message from Mrs McGonigle and Mr Fry

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have made it to the final week of term and I'm sure that you are all looking forward to spending some time with family and friends. Your children have been working extra hard as they focused on their learning in the build-up to the Christmas holidays. Children have pranced like a Reindeer, twirled like a snowflake, hopped like an Elf, sparkled like a Christmas star during the festive Santa Run.

A very special visitor came to take over Santa's Grotto in the school garden and met with all the children from Reception to Year 6 and brought them presents before the children went to classrooms to open them. All children had a special Christmas Lunch in the Main Hall, which was bedecked with large LED inflatable Santa Sleigh and Nutcracker, snow and lights projector and Christmas music; it was a beautiful and happy atmosphere. Staff have been focused on ensuring children have a really positive end to this term. Despite the ongoing challenges this term, I have been proud of what we have achieved. 




